Remembering Religious Liberty on Independence Day: As we approach the celebration of the birth of our nation, people of faith are encouraged to remember that our nation's founders embraced freedom of religion as an essential condition of a free and democratic society. They enshrined this vision in the First Amendment of the Bill of Rights, which guarantees that "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof." This has meant that churches and religious institutions are not only free to worship in their own way, but they are also free to exercise ministries of education, charity and social justice that reflect their fundamental beliefs and serve all people, regardless of faith or economic position. We encourage all parishioners to consider participating in Mass on July 4, and pray for the preservation of religious freedom. The Fortnight for Freedom is an opportunity for people of all faiths to remember that we should not confine our faith to just the worship space, but we have a human right to bring it to the public square for the common good of all who live in this land. Below are some suggestions to participate in the Fortnight for Freedom: 1) attend daily Mass, 2) skip a meal, 3) give up something, 4) make a sacrifice, 5) pray a rosary, 6) fast for one day or 7) go without meat for a day. Please make a commitment to do one or more of these between now and July 4.
