<u>CONFESSIONS</u>: In place of Eucharistic Adoration, on Holy Thursday, I will hear confessions from 4:30pm-6:00pm. This will be the last scheduled confessions before Easter.

**Divine Mercy Sunday**: The Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday, March 25 and continues through the Sunday after Easter, which is Divine Mercy Sunday, April 3. To honor the Solemnity, we will have Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and pray the Divine Mercy chaplet after the 11am Mass on Sunday, April 3. I encourage you to be present for this devotion which takes about fifteen minutes. A person can gain a Plenary Indulgence by observing Divine Mercy Sunday. A Plenary Indulgence remits all the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has been or will be forgiven in the sacrament of Confession. It is also necessary to receive Holy Communion on that day or the vigil and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, Pope Francis. Indulgences can be applied to oneself or the faithful departed.

<u>Votive Lights</u>: Beginning this weekend, no <u>LARGE</u> votive candles may be lit until after the Easter Vigil. The last day to light <u>SMALL</u> votive candles is the Wednesday of Holy Week.

<u>Fish Fry</u>: Our Lenten Fish Fry is held on Good Friday, from 4pm-7pm in Heritage Hall (under the church). Dine in, drive-thru or carry out. See the insert in this week's bulletin.

Good Friday (March 25) is a day of <u>strict</u> fast and abstinence. Abstinence means no eating of meat (beast or fowl) and is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years of age and older on all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal on a given fast day. Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 are obliged to fast on Good Friday. On fast days, two additional smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength. However, two smaller meals together may not equal one full meal. Moreover, eating solid foods between meals on fast days is not permitted.
