The Archdiocesan Golden Anniversary Mass honoring couples celebrating 50 years of marriage scheduled for August 1st at 4:30pm has been cancelled.



<u>UPPER LOT REPAIR</u>: Please be aware that over the next two weeks or so the upper lot is being repaired. So for now, if you are coming to church for Mass or Confessions or Adoration you will need to park on Warsaw or on Carson or behind the rectory or in the lower lot.



I am thrilled that we will begin to celebrate Mass together again. We will follow our normal daily Mass schedule and weekend Mass schedule. Confessions will be from 3-4 pm on Saturday afternoon. Eucharistic Adoration with confessions is Thursday afternoon from 3-5 pm.

For all Masses, we will observe health and safety guidelines. So, for example, we will observe social distancing: pews and seating within the pews have been marked. The side pews will be for families. There will be ushers available to help you with seating. You are welcome to wear a mask but it is <u>not</u> required. If you can, bring your own hand sanitizer. We do have some but it's limited. The maintenance staff will be disinfecting the church after Masses. It would be considerate of everybody to please refrain from attending Mass if you have a fever or any flu-like symptoms.

I have reinstituted the use of the Communion rail for the receiving of Holy Communion. Where you are to kneel at the Communion rail is clearly marked. Before Mass I will go over all of this along with the order of how we will have you come up for Communion and return to your seat.

The upper parking lot is still under construction. The construction crew is moving as fast as they are able. It should be completed soon. In the meantime, you can park on Warsaw or on Carson or behind the rectory and in the lower lot.

Again, I am thrilled that we are celebrating Mass together. See you in church.
