Parish Donation Update



- Many other parishioners submitted all of their contributions that accrued during the suspension when public masses resumed.

I am thrilled to celebrate Mass together again. We will follow our normal daily Mass schedule and weekend Mass schedule. Confessions will be from 3-4 pm on Saturday afternoon. Eucharistic Adoration with confessions is Thursday afternoon from 3-5 pm.

For all Masses, we will observe health and safety guidelines. So, for example, we will observe social distancing. Pews to remain empty have been closed off with gold string. The side pews will be for families. There will be ushers available to help you with seating. You are welcome to wear a mask but it is **not** required. The maintenance staff will be disinfecting the church after Masses. Please refrain from attending Mass if you have a fever or any flu-like symptoms.

For Communion, everyone will come up the center aisle in a staggered line, right or left, every 6 feet and return to the pews by the side aisles. Please come up to the Communion rail and kneel or stand. Before Mass, I will go over how you come up for Communion and return to your seat.
