

October

Habit 1: Be Proactive, is a habit that helps you to realize you are in charge of your life; you are responsible for your own choices and behaviors; you can choose how to react to other people and situations. The "Circle of Control" is a model that is meant to help people reflect on their decisions and behaviors as well as other people's decisions and behaviors. It's a visual diagram meant to display what is within your control and what isn't. This habit is vital in helping us all understand actions that are in our control and actions that aren't.



Habits at Home

Examples of how you can practice Habit 1 at home:

- 1)If you have a child that is constantly complaining of being bored, have them brainstorm ways that they could do something nice for someone else, either a neighbor, friend, or family member.
- 2) Circle of Control: Take some sidewalk chalk and go outside and draw two circles within each other big enough to stand in. The middle one is the circle of control. Give your kids examples of different things they can control



(homework) and other things they can't (weather). Have them move in and out of the circle depending on the scenario.

3) Roleplay: Proactive vs. Reactive. Demonstrate for your kids how to deal with a situation proactively vs. reactively.


